You are cordially invited to attend an ACTS retreat in 2013.

This is a Catholic retreat put on by lay people like yourself, and is our spiritual gift to you. If you would enjoy a weekend of relaxation and would like to investigate some aspects of your faith, then this is the weekend for you. We are confident that you will find the results richly rewarding.

The weekend will take place at the United Methodist Camp in Juneau, Alaska. The retreat begins Thursday evening at about 5:30 and concludes on Sunday with Mass and a potluck for team, retreatants and their families at St. Paul's Catholic Church in Juneau.

ACTS is inspired by the Acts of the Apostles 2:42-47. Trinitarian and Christocentric in scope and spirit, consciously emphasizing the mystery of God and the plan of salvation, which leads to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit (cf Eph. 1 :3-14). The center of the message is Christ, true God and true man, His saving work carried out in His incarnation, life, death and resurrection.

The various components of the retreat embody all these components to some degree.

No one will be denied due to financial hardship... scholarships are available.

COST

This retreat is offered at a cost of \$150 per person for the entire weekend. This includes transportation, all meals & lodging.

A non refundable registration fee of \$25.00 or payment in full must be submitted with the registration. A refund of all but \$25.00 will be issued up until 14 days before the retreat. After that time there will be no refunds.

If the retreat has an opening, this payment will secure your place. If the retreat is full you will be notified and your name will be placed on the waiting list.

The unpaid balance must be paid in full 30 days before the retreat.

Partial scholarships are available for each retreat. Requests must be made in writing and submitted to the ACTS Board or emailed to stpauls@ptialaska.net.

Registrations will NOT be accepted less than 10 days prior to the retreat.

*If you cannot attend, you must notify ACTS by phone or email 14 days or more days before check-in for the retreat for a refund.

The Texas Connection

ACTS began in Southeast Alaska the summer of 1997.

A group of men from San Antonio, Texas came to join the team of local men. The next year local women teamed up with Texas women to initiate the women's ACTS retreat. In 2001 the teen ACTS retreats began with many of the team coming from Texas.

Our ACTS community has grown to over 1000 individuals. Retreatants have come from different local faith communities, including St. Paul's, The Cathedral, Chapel by the Lake, Valley Chapel, St. Brendan's, Resurrection Lutheran, Church of Latter Day Saints.

ACTS

ACTS is an acronym signifying Adoration, Community, Theology and Service.

The **PURPOSE** of the weekend is to inspire the retreatants to a new or deeper relationship with the Lord and fellow parishioners through:

Adoration and daily prayer.

Community in one's parish as a member of the Body of Christ.

Theology or the teachings of our Christian faith by encouraging more study of our faith and God's Word. Instilling a virtue that will call each of us to

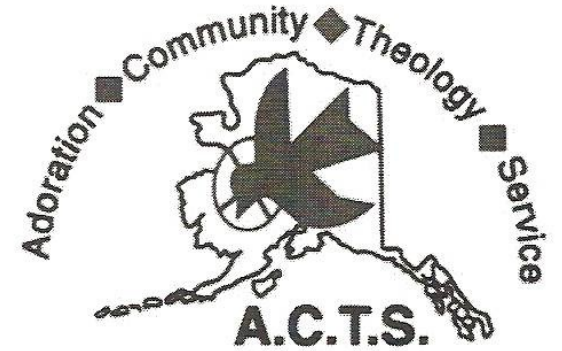
Service to our Lord, our parish and each other.
